Long Winter's Night

An SCCA Divisional Endurance Rally

February 9, 1980

Rainier Auto Sports Club, organizers of the Nor'wester and Tour de Forest National Pro Auto Rallies, announce their first presentation of the Long Winter's Night, an endurance rally for the novice or experienced competitor. Neither a stage rally nor a conventional TSD event, Long Winter's Night will carry sanction by the Sports Car Club of America as part of a new group of Divisional Pro rallies.

FORMAT - The Long Winter's Night will be a straightforward Monte Carlo style event in the tradition of many european rallies and Mexico's Rally Internacional De Las 24 Horas. Speeds will be brisk but within legal limits and course following kept simple with all instructions supplemented by tulip diagram and mileage. Further explanation and a sample page from the route book will be included in the regulations, available after January 20th.

ROUTE - The rally will start in the Bellevue area and finish near Everett, covering about 350 miles of paved, smooth, public roads in the northwest corner of the state. Fuel will be available every 150 miles and the total time will be 9 or 10 hours.

TECH REQUIREMENTS - Vehicles must be street legal and in sound, roadworthy condition. Flares, fire extinguisher, and 3 or 4 point seat belts are required, and roll bars for convertibles. Snow tires are suggested but not required, and no fuel cans or extra passengers are allowed.

CLASSES - 1) PRO - Driver has finished a national stage rally. This class is optional for those elgible, and equipment is open.
2) CPEN - No restrictions on timing or navigational equipment.
3) SOP - Limited to stock odometer and stopwatch.

ENTRY & AWARDS - Starting position within class will be in order of receipt of entry. The entry fee is \$30.00 and includes a buffet breakfast for two at the finish. Class winners will receive trophies plus cash awards, and a minimum of \$400.00 in contingency money is available from Jaguar Rover Triumph Inc. and SAAB-SCANDIA for finishers in their vehicles. Full details will be in the regulations.
